1. Supplies and Materials for the First Year Studios

As you enter Cornish, you are expected to acquire supplies just as you would buy textbooks. Below is a list designed to encompass the basic needs of many first-year required studio courses. All tools will continue to be useful throughout your years of study at Cornish and beyond. Additional tools or supplies may need to be purchased throughout the year for specific classes, projects, or personal work outside of class.

Required Supplies:

General Music Supplies:

- ☐ **Notebook(s) and Pens:** For taking notes in all classes, especially in theory, history, and analysis courses.
- ☐ **Manuscript Paper:** For notating music. You can find this at any music store or online.
- ☐ **Portable Digital Recorder:** Useful for recording rehearsals, lessons, and practice sessions (smartphones with a solid recording app works great).
- ☐ **Tuner and Metronome:** Can be separate devices or combined (many smartphone apps are available).
- ☐ **Binder:** To keep sheet music and handouts organized.

Instruments:

- ☐ **Personal Instrument:** Students are expected to have their primary instrument for practice and performance. For vocalists, this includes their voice, and ensuring they have appropriate vocal care supplies.
- ☐ **Instrument Accessories:** Depending on the instrument, this may include reeds, strings, rosin, valve oil, etc.
- ☐ **Headphones:** Quality over-ear headphones for critical listening and recording sessions.

2. Incoming Student Laptop Requirements & Recommendations

As a Music Major, having a capable laptop is essential for your career. Therefore, all Music Majors are **required** to have a technologically advanced laptop (Apple or PC), and a subscription to Ableton Live 12.

Important Note: Only information provided by Cornish Admissions or your program's Chair regarding these requirements is accurate. ***Do not listen to anyone who suggests downloading bootleg music software for free or using alternative open-source software.*** This information is incorrect, and students who have ignored these requirements are experiencing major difficulties in their classes.
