Fast Track – MSCS Application Instructions

As a Fast Track student, you have less requirements you must complete on the MSCS application. However, there is not a separate MSCS application specifically for Fast Track students. Therefore, there are certain steps you must take to bypass the requirements on the application. Please read the instructions carefully before filling out your application. Before you start filling out your application, please make sure that you have submitted the Fast Track Intent Form first.

GRE

The GRE is not required. Please leave this question blank.

Letter of Intent

You do not need to write a letter of intent. Please create a simple word document with your name that says that you are a fast track student and submit this document to bypass the letter of intent requirement.

Prerequisite Form

Please fill out the prerequisite form completely with the appropriate corresponding courses you've taken (or are currently taking) for your undergraduate degree. Here is a sample of what your prerequisite form might look like.

Recommenders

You do not need to ask for any actual recommendations. On the MSCS application, you can list Professor Eric Larson (elarson@seattleu.edu) **twice**. This will waive your recommendation requirement.

Resume

You do not need to submit your actual resume. Just like the Letter of Intent requirement, please upload a word document with your name that states that you are a fast track student.

Transcripts

You do not need to submit a transcript.

Enrollment Deposit

You will be asked to pay a \$250 Enrollment Deposit upon accepting the admission offer to MSCS. This deposit will go towards your first quarter tuition bill.
