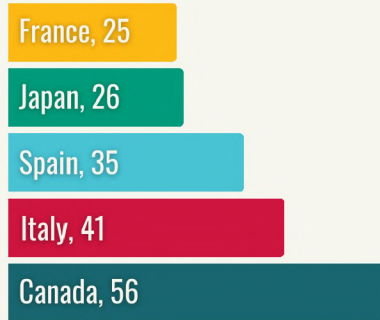

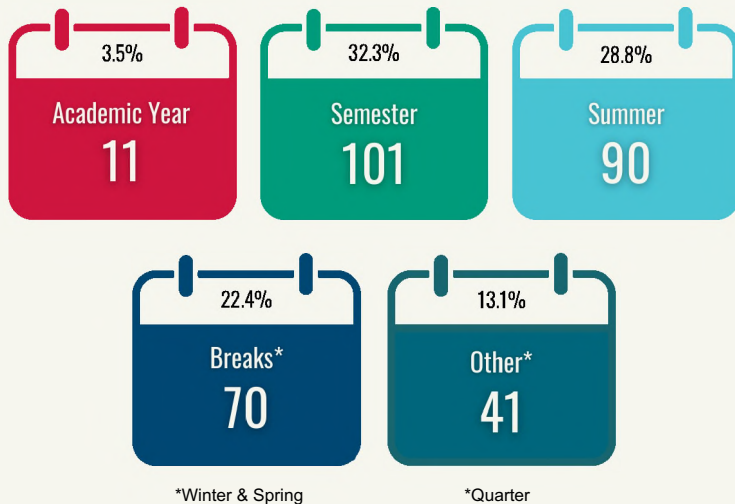

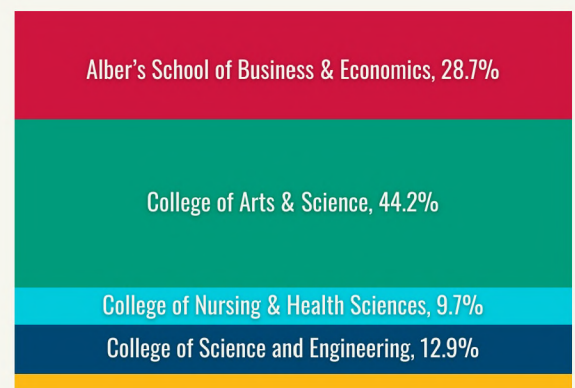
Percentage, Term, and # of Participants

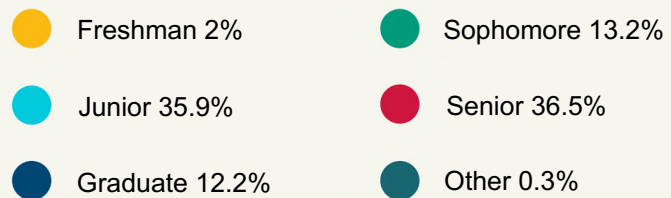

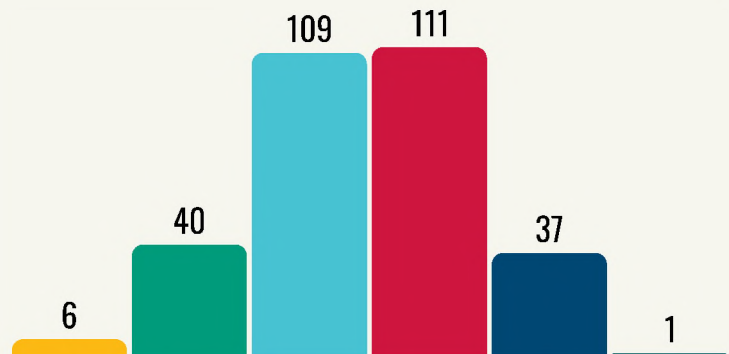
Year, Percentage, # of Participants
