Please note that J-1 students are not authorized to work in the United States except under special circumstances or through part-time on-campus employment. On-campus jobs are not guaranteed, and you should not plan on supporting your education through employment while being a student.

In addition to this Declaration of Finances form, international students must show evidence of the financial support being indicated on page 2. Such evidence is typically provided through current bank statements or bank letters.

Guidelines for the bank statement/letter:

- Must be dated within the last six months.
- The name of the bank and of the account holder must be included.
- The current total account balance must be shown (we cannot accept a letter indicating only "adequate funds", "balance in the low six figures", "good customer", etc.).
- The type of currency must be indicated.
- The type of account (e.g. savings, checking, time deposit) must be indicated.
- Must be in English or include an English translation.
- Photocopies and facsimiles of signatures and bank documents are acceptable.
- Letters of financial guarantee from government or other institutional sponsors must include the name of the award recipient, state the period of time covered by the award, and indicate Seattle University as the student's authorized institution of attendance.
- Personal sponsors other than immediate family members will be required to submit an additional letter of support. Information about the content of this letter will be provided by Seattle University International Admissions.
