

## 2025 - 2026 DECLARATION OF FINANCES

#### International Graduate Students

### **Instructions and Important Information**

- Complete the Financial Worksheet on page two
  - Total Resources Needed
    - Estimated costs are for one academic year (a minimum of six credits per quarter for three quarters)
    - Transportation costs to and from the United States are not included in the estimated costs
    - Plan accordingly, should your program design require more credits or terms
  - Living Expenses
    - Cannot be waived for I-20 issuance even if you have your own living arrangements
  - Dependents
    - Eligible dependents include spouse, children (under the age of twenty-one and unmarried)
    - If you bring dependents, you must submit a scan of each dependent's passport
- Immigration policies require Seattle University to verify financial resources of all international
  applicants. Collect and submit financial documents ("Proof of Funding") that meet or exceed the
  "Estimated Total Costs" you calculated
  - Photocopies or electronic copies of signatures and bank documents are acceptable
  - o Financial documents must be no more than six (6) months old
  - Acceptable documents can include a bank statement, a bank letter with current available balance, or a letter from a lending agency that certifies loan approval and amount(s)
  - Assets must be liquid, not stocks or property. Financial assets used to demonstrate the ability to cover costs of attendance must have been in existence for at least six (6) months
  - A student receiving a scholarship from their government or employer must submit a letter verifying the details of the scholarship award. The letter must include your name, the name of the government, agency, or employer, and the terms and amount of the scholarship
  - Students should not plan to support their education through employment while being a student
- Sign and date the Statement of Responsibility section. By signing, you certify that you and/or your sponsor have access to funding that meets or exceeds the amount on line 11 in the Financial Worksheet
- If applicable, have your sponsor complete, sign, and date the Sponsor Section
- All portions of this Declaration of Finances form must be complete before Seattle University will issue an I-20
- Complete this form fully, then upload it to your student portal
