Project Proposal Guidelines

(Minimum 11-point font with 1-inch margins, maximum 2 pages. Note that the review panel will be comprised of faculty and professionals from a variety of EJS disciplines; please write your proposal with this audience in mind.) Please describe:

- 1. Intended objective(s) of the project.
- 2. The methodology you will employ.
- 3. Discuss the significance of your project both within your discipline and in relation to the larger concerns and advancement of environmental justice or sustainability.
- 4. Discuss how your project uses appropriate or novel collaboration, particularly across disciplines.
- 5. Discuss how your project will contribute to your educational and professional goals and to the university's "Laudato Si'" commitment to integral ecology.
- 6. Discuss the viability of your project by including the project timeline and an estimate of required resources.
- 7. Describe the project's intended results (such as a tangible scholarly product, an academic paper, a conference presentation, an artistic exhibit or presentation, or other pre-professional product,...).
- 8. Describe the potential for publication/other dissemination and for impact/continuity of the project beyond the one-year CEJS fellowship (e.g. possible contribution to a larger grant,...).
- 9. List all current or pending fellowships or grants, indicating the funding period.
