

Credit/No Credit (CR/NC)*

Credit/No Credit is a grading designation assigned to courses by the department, typically for internships, practica, or other experiential learning-based courses. Deans may collaborate with the Provost's Office on other appropriate uses.

CR/NC is not an option selected by students. C is the minimum grade to earn CR. CR/NC grades are used to calculate satisfactory academic progress, but they do not affect the student's GPA.

Credits for all CR grades count toward cumulative degree requirements and are included as credits completed on the transcript.
