- 4. Submit your Course Preference Form before you schedule your advising appointment. Appointments are available beginning June 2nd!

PREPARING FOR ADVISING AND REGISTRATION

You can see an overview of the advising process on the <u>New Student Advising and</u> <u>Registration webpage</u>. Be sure to complete the following tasks:

- Course Preference Form: The purpose of this form is to provide insight to your
 academic advisor that will guide your conversation about your course
 registration. This form must first be submitted before you are granted access to
 schedule your academic advising appointment.
- Online Orientation Module: <u>Before you attend your advising appointment</u>, complete the Academic Advising Module in Canvas. This module explains how academic advising works, reviews academic terms, and shares resources available for advising support.
