

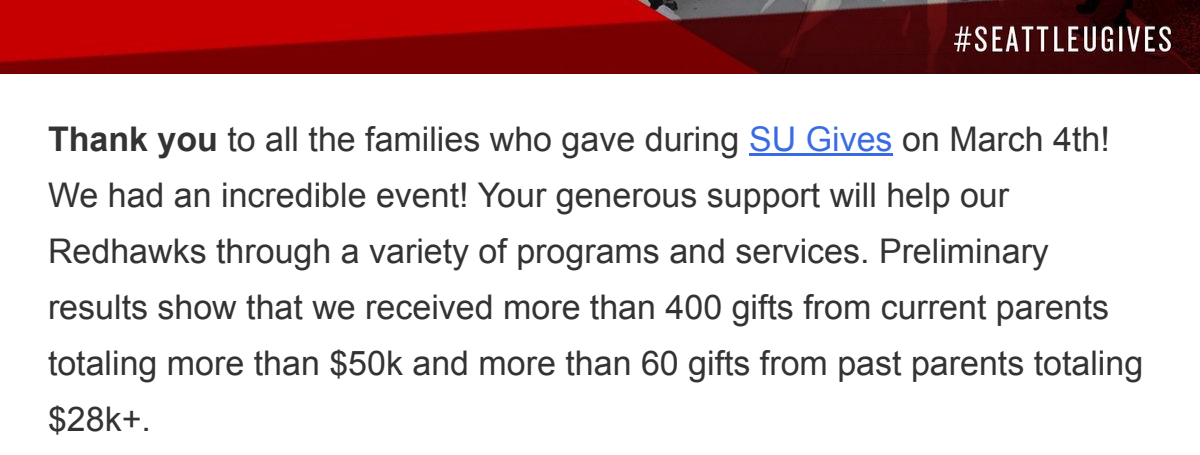

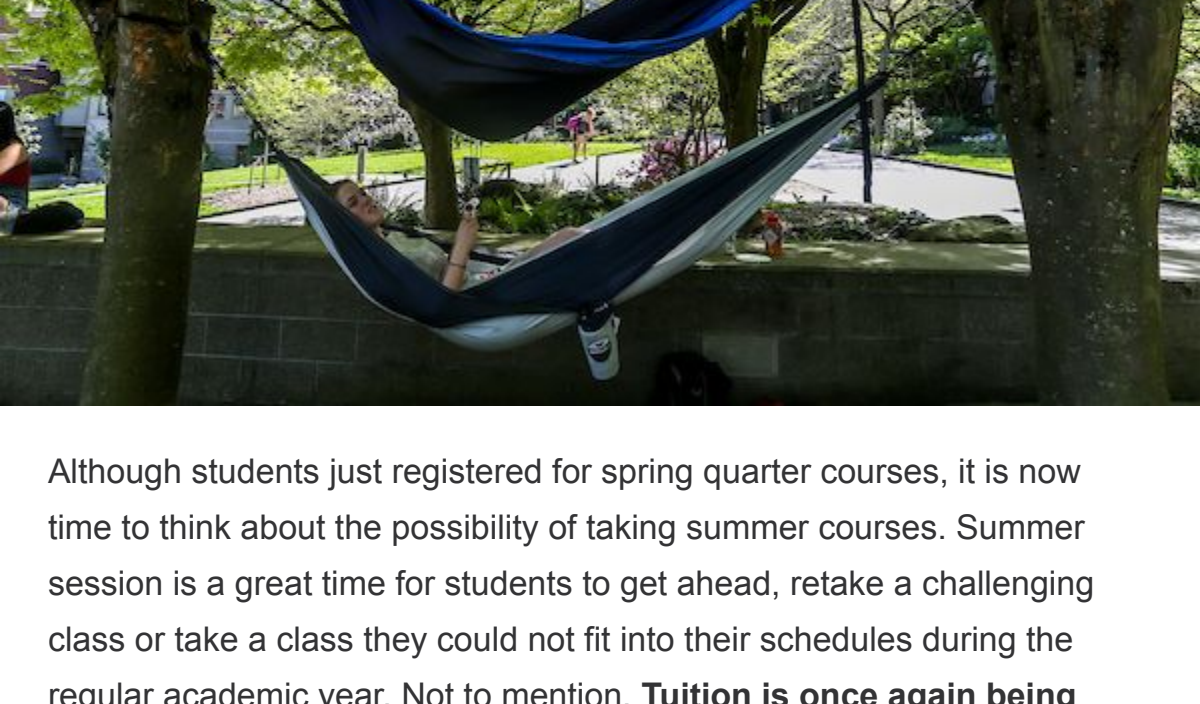
On-Track Summer Grant Program

We recognize that the transition from high school to the academic pace and rigor at the University level can stretch many students and sometimes lead to grades lower than they expected. As an example of our commitment to helping students get back on track academically, we are pleased to offer the On-Track Summer Grant program for students meeting the established criteria this summer quarter 2025.

First-year, undergraduate students that entered SU in either Fall 2024 or Winter 2025 that received a D+, D, D-, F or W grade in two or more courses are eligible to receive a **Seattle University On-Track Summer Grant, equivalent to the cost of tuition for two undergraduate summer courses**. The On-Track Summer Grant may only be applied to courses taken this summer quarter 2025 and is not transferable to other academic terms. Mandatory fees for the summer quarter still apply and are not covered by the On-Track Summer grant.

Eligible students are encouraged to schedule a meeting with their academic advisor to discuss what summer course/s being offered would be most beneficial for their major or academic interests. Most summer courses are offered on-line so students that will not be in Seattle or with other summer commitments can still access this opportunity. Summer Classes



Although students just registered for spring quarter courses, it is now time to think about the possibility of taking summer courses. Summer session is a great time for students to get ahead, retake a challenging class or take a class they could not fit into their schedules during the regular academic year. Not to mention, **Tuition is once again being reduced by 40 percent for all undergraduate classes** offered during Summer 2025.

 - Proxy Access** allows family/supporter to speak to SFS Office about account status, balance, award letter, and required documentation.
 - Authorized User Access** allows family/supporter login access view billing and payment information, setup payment plans, see tax documents, and get email notifications about billing invoicing.
