### FAFSA/WASFA

- Open now
- If eligible to file the only way to get federal funding or State Need Grant
- Should fill out even if you only think you qualify for loans
- Some scholarships require Student Aid Report (SAR)
- ◄ Info is protected only goes to Dept of Education or WA State
- Report on 2017 tax data
- No need to pay for help filling out form

Personal Statement

<500 words

Use one for multiple applications

Make sure you answer the prompt

Ask multiple people to review

Transcripts/ Test Scores

> Unofficial can be obtained on SU Online

Official is ordered from Registrar's Office

SAT/ACT scores sometimes required Letters of Rec

Ask people who know you well

Ask early

Student Aid Report (SAR)

Shows
Estimated
Family
Contribution
(EFC)

Not required by all scholarships

- Fill out as much of profile as possible
- Most are due January March

- Fees to apply
- No phone number or contact info
- No proof of past winners
- Request personal financial info
- Claim to do all the work for you
- Claim that "you can't get this information anywhere else"

Exam Name	Eligibility Criteria
Law School Admission	-Inability to pay for the LSAT and Credential Assembly Service
Test	-Be a US, Canadian, or Australian citizen, a US
(LSAT)	national, a US permanent resident, or have applied/been granted DACA status.
